

Scholarship: Grit & STEAM Challenge

Sponsored by: Mojave Transportation Museum & Mojave Chamber of Commerce

Description:

The Mojave Transportation Museum will offer a \$500 Grit & STEAM Challenge scholarship to one graduating senior from Mojave High School.

The board members of the Mojave Transportation Museum truly believe in the power of perseverance. No matter what you call it – grit, determination or tenacity – persistence is the key ingredient in achieving a goal. Being persistent in your purpose, especially in spite of difficulties, obstacles, or discouragement is how people accomplish great things.

We also believe in the importance of a STEAM education to create well-rounded students and believe combining perseverance with a STEAM education helps to create some of the smartest and most well-rounded adults – no matter what profession.

Objective:

The team at MTM hopes to encourage applicants to discover the importance of perseverance and a STEAM education through collaboration, professional interviews and personal reflection.

In addition, we hope applicants will challenge themselves to reach outside their comfort zone in meeting new people, asking questions and learning from a professional about their personal perseverance in their profession and life in general.

By using a unique collaboration interview, MTM hopes to inspire creativity and allow applicants to think outside the box.

Requirements:

- Applicant must be a graduating senior at Mojave High School
- 20 Hours of Community Service
- Applicant must complete one in-person interview with a working professional (see requirements below)
- Applicant must submit a project that represents a "lesson learned" or a "key takeaway" from the interview.

Awards:

- All applicants will be invited to an end of the year banquet
- One winner will receive a \$500 scholarship
- Raffle prizes will be awarded at the banquet



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Interview Process and Requirements:

- Applicants can partner with ANY professional adult. However, it is recommended to interview someone in a profession of interest to the applicant.
- Interviews MUST be in person.
- After confirmation of scheduling an interview, each applicant will receive a toolkit with materials to create their project. Please email <u>info@mojavemuseum.org</u> with confirmed interviewee, time and place.
- There are TWO goals for the interview:
 - Through interview questions and conversation, applicant will learn the professional's definition of PERSERVERENCE and ask about examples in their personal or professional life.
 - After reflecting on the interview, students will use the provided toolkit and one or multiple elements of STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and/or Math) to create a project that represents a lesson learned from the interview.
- Applicants MUST use at least one item from their toolkit to create their project. (Examples: A poem, a song, a sculpture, a hypothesis, an essay, a working mechanism, a drawing, etc.)

Tips for Success:

- Tell your interviewee what to expect for the interview (ie. How long it will be, generally what the questions will be about, etc.)
- Be on time! Be respectful of your interviewee's time and make sure you arrive a little early.
- Start with some get-to-know-you questions (ie. Where are they from? How long have they worked in their current position? Do they have pets? Did they go to college?, etc.)
- What should you CREATE? Be creative, us elements of STEAM that speak to YOU. . (Examples: A poem, a song, a sculpture, a hypothesis, an essay, a working mechanism, a drawing, etc.)
